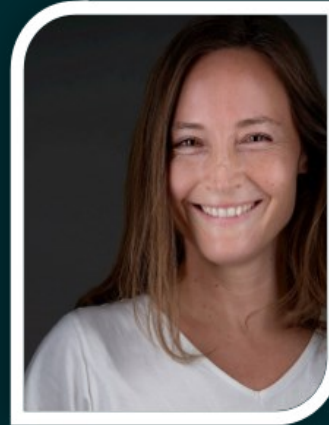

BIODIVERSITY PROJECTS / ELEMENTS

Tanzania: Savannah grassland restoration Grumeti Reserves

Objective is to restore the natural grassland savanna habitat of the Nyigoti village land and Nyakitono open area through via the establishment of (i) a biodiversity crediting project then (ii) a rotational grazing carbon project through a partnership between Grumeti Reserves and the traditional community landowners .

Mozambique: biodiversity restoration, Karingani GR

Objective is to restore, enhance and maintain the natural ecological processes and biodiversity of Karingani Game Reserve through an effective and sustainable partnership between the Mozambican Government, private investors and local communities – the Karingani Ecosystem Rewilding and Restoration Project («KERRP»).

IMPROVED FIRE MANAGEMENT – SAVANNA / MIOMBO LANDSCAPES

Zambia: Kasempa Lunga Lushwishi

Objective is to secure the long-term financial viability of management of the Kasempa hunting block within the Lunga Luswishi ecosystem and to protect this critical wilderness area and the biodiversity it contains whilst generating financial, climate and community returns via carbon credit sales. Size: 734,000ha

Tanzania: Grumeti Reserves

Objective is to generate new revenues via the sale of carbon credits to offset the high annual costs of managing the Grumeti Reserves, using carbon market methodologies that do not disrupt the movement of the Great Migration, the availability and timing of graze for game, or the tourist experience.
